



Privacy Policy

Grange Capital, LLC recognizes that protecting the privacy and security of the confidential personal information we collect about you is an important responsibility. The following information will help you understand our privacy policy and how we maintain and protect your confidential “personal information”. “Personal information” refers to the nonpublic financial and personal information that we have obtained in connection with providing you financial services.

We will not disclose personal information about current or former clients to non-affiliated third parties except as permitted or required by law. We do not sell any personal information about you to any third party. In the normal course of business, personal information may be shared with persons or entities involved in servicing and administering products and services on our behalf, including your accountant, attorney, broker, and other service providers and affiliates assisting us.

We collect personal information to help us serve your financial needs, provide customer service, and fulfill legal and regulatory requirements. The type of information that we collect varies according to the products or services involved, and may include:

- Information we received from you on account applications and related forms such as name, address, social security number, assets and income.
- Information about your transactions such as services, account balances and payment history as well as information pertaining to your relationships with Grange Capital, LLC and our affiliates.

Protecting the confidentiality and security of personal information:

We have procedures in place that limit access to personal information to those employees and service providers who need to know such information to perform business services on our behalf. We emphasize to our employees the importance of protecting the privacy and security of confidential personal information. We also maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards that comply with federal and state regulations to protect your personal information.
